A colourful initiative brings smiles to young patients at HGH

Your generosity is helping to provide colouring sets to families visiting HGH's Emergency Department



A colourful and heart-warming project

Every year, the HGH Emergency Department welcomes nearly 5,600 children. As you can imagine, it can be a long and anxious wait for little patients. To keep them entertained while waiting for treatment, the ED team called on the HGH Foundation to help provide each child with a special colouring book and pencils.

The project was entrusted to Eve de Grosbois, Donor Relations Officer at the Foundation. From the outset, she enthusiastically took on the task, but was soon disappointed by the options available on the market, which she found too generic. "What I found wasn't super pretty, nor personalized, and above all made on the other side of the planet," she explains. She then decided to find a more original and meaningful solution, by associating HGH with PiCO, a Canadian company renowned for its creative products for children.

Convinced that they could create something special, Eve contacted the company's owners, who were touched by the project and immediately got on board, even volunteering to do all the graphics for the book. The result: a colouring book tailor-made for HGH, with captivating drawings to entertain and reassure children. And a charming detail, the cover proudly features Dr. Leo the Lion, the Foundation's little stuffed animal!

The distribution of the colouring sets began last November, much to everyone's delight!

A touching element that Eve made a point of integrating into the colouring book was a special page children can colour and write a thank-you message to someone at the hospital they particularly appreciated during their visit. This page, which they can then detach and offer a staff member, is a small gesture of gratitude that helps strengthen the bond between the children and the caring staff.

The Foundation was able to help HGH because of YOU!


HGH recently asked the Foundation to help purchase the **Jackson Spine Table** in order to offer spine surgery in Hawkesbury. The need in our community was clear and we have contributed \$175,000. We're thrilled to report that HGH's first spine surgery took place on January 6, 2025!



You see, the Foundation is committed to addressing urgent needs and acquiring advanced equipment and care to reduce the necessity of redirecting patients outside of HGH. We are deeply dedicated to meeting the critical needs of HGH's patients, but this is only possible thanks to the unwavering support of wonderful donors like you! Thank you!

We're almost there!

Our fundraising campaign, *There's No Place Like Home*, will **soon be over!** You have helped transform the services and care offered at HGH. Thanks to YOUR generosity, nearly \$2.6 million has been raised so far, allowing our hospital to purchase specialized equipment and introduce new medical and surgical procedures to better serve you and your loved ones.



But, we still need your help!

Just under \$230,000 remains to be raised to reach our campaign goal. These funds will help expand the urology program and complete the expansion of the ophthalmology program to provide the highly demanded diagnostics and treatments at HGH, which patients currently have to travel to major centers to receive.

With 92% of our goal reached, we hope to be able to celebrate the completion of the campaign this spring!

Our accomplishments

Mammography: In February 2024, tomosynthesis, a 3D mammographic imaging technology, arrived at HGH! This advancement is crucial for the early detection and treatment of invasive breast cancer, thereby increasing the chances of recovery.

Endoscopy: The equipment for a second endoscopy suite has doubled the number of procedures performed at HGH since fall 2024. This increase is essential for cancer prevention and detection.

Ophthalmology: Phase 1 of ophthalmology has allowed for cataract surgeries to be performed at HGH since December 2021.

Orthopedic Surgery: The purchase of specialized equipment has enabled orthopedic interventions, including hip and knee replacements, to be performed at HGH since December 2020. This has not only improved access to care for patients but also reduced waiting times.

Cardiology: Acquisition of a third transthoracic echocardiography (TTE) suite in March 2023. This new installation has significantly increased the capacity for weekly exams, providing faster and more accurate diagnoses.
