## About the Hospital

The **Hawkesbury and District General Hospital (HGH)** is a bilingual, full-service regional hospital providing compassionate, safe and high-quality patient care to the residents of Prescott-Russell in Eastern Ontario and surrounding areas. HGH delivers a full range of programs and services from its main campus and the Mental Health and Addiction Regional Centre in Hawkesbury, and two satellite centres in Clarence-Rockland and Casselman respectively. HGH is transforming into a regional model hospital in Ontario through its major redevelopment project and a \$200-million investment in state-of-the-art technology and infrastructure.

## About the Role

As Chief Executive Officer (CEO), you will play a critical leadership role in the Hawkesbury and District General Hospital's transformation while guiding this growing organization of "Dedicated people pursuing healthcare excellence through teamwork, innovation and leadership" to new levels of excellence. Reporting to the Board of Directors, you will provide direction for HGH on strategy and organizational effectiveness; people leadership and culture; programs, resources and financial stewardship; communication and counsel; advocacy and ambassadorship; and medical and clinical affairs.

With a patient-centred focus, you will establish the Hospital's annual operational plan, and ensure the alignment of the Hospital's corporate strategic plan, administrative structure, organizational culture, and quality and business systems in pursuit of the HGH's strategic priorities. Leading by example, you will measure and monitor organizational effectiveness using best practice methods across a balanced scorecard of performance metrics that define the organization's quality improvement priorities and broader strategic priorities.

As CEO, you will ensure that effective systems are in place to support, deploy and sustain programs and services, facilitate operational performance improvement in all sectors, as well as apprise the Board of organizational performance results along with plans to sustain or improve said performance. As patient care expectations and delivery systems change, your strengths as a transformational leader will enable you to evolve the organizational strategy, structure, culture and skills to support these changes and drive continued success.

This is an exciting opportunity to be a role model for HGH core values and lead the ongoing development of a just culture focused on continuous improvement, as well as an active sponsor for large-scale organizational change initiatives by being active and visible throughout the change process.
